

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED BY THE COURT that the said Kathryn Roy, deceased, was a widow at the time of her death and left surviving as her sole and only heir-at-law the following named persons, all of legal age:

Hubertha Sobiescyk, a daughter, Grand Island, Nebraska;
Martin Roy, a son, Grand Island, Nebraska;
Altorla Ballard, a daughter, also known as Alatorla Ballard, San Diego, California.

The Court further finds that the Administrator, Martin Roy, has accounted for all of the property of the said Kathryn Roy, deceased, which has come into his possession or knowledge and has in all things complied with the orders of this Court.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED BY THE COURT that the said final report is hereby confirmed and approved in all respects.

The Court further finds that the time fixed for filing claims against said estate has long since expired; that notice of the time fixed for filing claims has been given in the manner and form provided by law; that all claims filed have been paid and that any outstanding claims or obligations against said estate are forever barred and precluded.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED BY THE COURT that the time set for filing claims against said estate has expired; that all claims filed have been paid and that all claims and obligations not now on file are forever barred and precluded.

The Court further finds that all debts, expenses of last illness, funeral expenses, administration expenses, including Court costs and attorney fees have been paid in full and receipts filed therefor with the Court.

The Court further finds that the Administrator, Martin Roy, has in open Court waived all claims for executor fees due him according to law.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED BY THE COURT that all claims against said Estate have been fully paid
