This cause came on for hearing on this 23 day of June, 1906, upon the final report of Almada Watson, Administratrix of the estate of Isaac K. Watson, deceased, at its appearing to the Court from the probators all persons interested in said estate have been duly notified under the orders of this Court, and after a full examination of said account, the Court finds that the same is correct in all respects and ought to be allowed.
