

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED BY THE COURT that the said John K. Watson, deceased, was a widower at the time of his death, being predeceased in death by his wife, Nellie May Watson; that the deceased left surviving as his sole and only heirs-at-law, devisees and legatees, the following persons:

all of whom are of legal age; that the above named persons are the only children of the deceased and that he left surviving him no child or children of a deceased child.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED BY THE COURT that upon the death of the said John K. Watson, deceased, the South-Half of the Southeast Quarter (36.36) of Section Twenty-one (21), Township Ten (10) North, Range Twelve (12), West of the 6th P. M. in Hall County, Nebraska, descended in accordance with the terms and provisions of the Last Will and Testament of John K. Watson, deceased, as follows:

1/31st interest therein to Dale K. Watson, also known as Dale Watson, his son;
1/21st interest therein to Alice A. Turner, also known as Alice Turner, his daughter;
1/21st interest therein to Verda M. Riche, also known as Verda Riche, his daughter.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED BY THE COURT that all claims and obligations of the deceased have been paid and that any claims and obligations existing against the Estate of John K. Watson, deceased, are forever barred and precluded; that the real estate belonging to the deceased deceased and descended as above set forth and that further administration of said Estate is herewith dispensed with; that the court costs of these proceedings and all other expenses have been paid and said Estate is finally closed and settled.
