Now on this 23rd day of September, 1953, this cause came on for hearing upon the Final Report filed herein by Orr Cummings, Executor of the estate of Marie Julia Cummings, deceased, and upon his Petition for approval and allowance of said Report, settlement of said estate, determination of heirs and his discharge herein, and the Court having examined the records and files, and being fully advised in the premises finds:

That Orr Cummings filed his Petition in this Court on March 3, 1953, alleging among other things, that Marie Julia Cummings departed this life testate on the 8th day of April, 1952; that at the time of her death, she was a resident and inhabitant of said County, and the owner of an estate to be administered in said County; that upon the filing and reading of said petition, an order was entered fixing a time and place for hearing the evidence in support of said Petition, giving notice thereof to all concerned by publishing said notice for three (3) successive weeks in the Grand Island Daily Independent, a legal newspaper published and circulated in said County;

That said hearing was held, as ordered by the Court; that letters testamentary were granted to Orr Cummings upon the filing of his bond in this Court, as by law required;

That due and legal notice has been given to all persons of the time and place fixed by the Court for filing claims against said estate by publication for three (3) successive weeks in the Grand Island Daily Independent; that all persons having claims against said estate not filed within the time fixed by the Court, if any such there be, should be forever barred, excluded and enjoined from setting up or asserting any such claims against said estate.
