

allowed within the time fixed by the Court, if any such there be, are forever barred, excluded and enjoined from setting up or asserting any such claims against said estate.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED by the Court that the following named are the heirs at law and only heirs at law, of the deceased:

Orr Cummings, husband, Grand Island, Nebraska, legal age
Frances Theona Eldridge, daughter, Grand Island, Nebraska, legal age
William Orr Cummings, son, United States Navy, legal age
James Scott Cummings, son, United States Navy, a minor
Larry Gene Cummings, son, Beatrice, Nebraska, a minor

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED by the Court that the said Marie Julia Cummings died owner of the following described property, to-wit:

An undivided one-half (1/2) interest as tenants in common with Orr Cummings in Lot Twelve (12), Block One (1), in Axt and Hage Addition to the City of Grand Island, Nebraska.

That under the terms of the Last Will and Testament, title to the above described property descended and vested in Orr Cummings as sole devisee and legatee.

Title to Lot One (1) Block One (1) in Mann's Second Addition to the City of Grand Island, Nebraska, was owned by the deceased as joint tenants with right of survivorship with Orr Cummings, her husband,

that Orr Cummings being the sole, remaining survivor and the owner of the said property; that the deceased paid no money for her share and interest in this described property held as joint tenants and not as tenants in common; the Court finds that the said estate is not subject to the payment of any inheritance tax under the laws of the State of Nebraska, or the estate tax to the United States of America.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, ADJUDGED, AND DECREED by the court that the Final Report, as filed by Orr Cummings, Executor, be and the same is hereby found to be correct and is hereby approved and allowed; that said estate is herewith settled and closed; that the said Executor is herewith discharged and sureties on his official bond are released from further liability in said estate.
