

LAST WILL AND TESTAMENT OF DALLAS P. WETZEL
OF NORFOLK, MADISON COUNTY, NEBRASKA

In accordance with an agreement between my wife, Elizabeth Wetzel, and myself, based upon considerations which we deem valuable and sufficient, to the effect that upon the death of the survivor of us all of our property then owned by the survivor, shall go to the same persons, in the same amounts, and shares as set out in respective Wills, published and declared by each of us this day, which Wills shall be irrevocable except by written revocation and consent signed by both of us, and in performance of my part of this agreement, I, Dallas P. Wetzel of the City of Norfolk, Madison County, Nebraska, do hereby make, publish, and declare this to be my Last Will and Testament as follows, to-wit:

1. After the payment of my debts and proper charges against my estate, I give, devise, and bequeath all of my property of every kind and description, real, personal, and mixed, unto my wife, Elizabeth Wetzel, if she survives me.
2. If she dies first I then give, devise and bequeath my property, real and personal, as follows:
3. I give and bequeath unto Emma Cisler, mother of my wife, the sum of \$500.00, if she survives me.
4. I give and bequeath unto my father, F. L. Wetzel of Norfolk, Nebraska, the sum of \$500.00, if he survives me.
5. I give and bequeath unto my mother, Lydia Wetzel, the sum of \$500.00, if she survives me.
6. All the rest and residue of my property of every kind and description, including lapsed legacies, if any, I give, devise, and bequeath unto my son, Clarence A. Wetzel, and my daughter, Viola L. Compton, share and share alike.
7. I nominate and appoint my wife to act as executrix of this my Last Will and Testament without bond, if she survives me, otherwise I direct the Court to appoint Dewey P. Wetzel as executor to qualify in accordance with law.

8. I hereby revoke all former Wills made by me, again declare this to be my Last Will and Testament, this instrument to be irrevocable except by written revocation and consent signed by myself and my wife, Elizabeth Wetzel.
