

IN THE COUNTY COURT OF HALL COUNTY, NEBRASKA

In the Matter of the Estate of Tena Beck, Deceased

Final Decree No. 4582

BE IT REMEMBERED that on this 15th day of October, A.D., 1953, it being the day fixed for approving the final account of the executors and hearing on their petition for final settlement and determination of heirship, and it appearing from proof on file that due notice was given by publication of the time fixed for said hearing, and there being no objections on file, and the court being fully advised in the premises, finds:

1. That Tena Beck died testate on April 20, 1953, a resident of Grand Island, Hall County, Nebraska, and left surviving her as her next of kin and heirs at law, Wilbur R. Beck and Delbert G. Beck, sons, both of Grand Island, Nebraska, and both of legal age; that she left no husband, other living children, or the living issue of any deceased children, and that said sons are the sole and only heirs of her estate.

2. That on May 20, 1953, the last will and testament of said Tena Beck, deceased, was duly proved, allowed, and admitted to probate, and on said day Wilbur R. Beck and Delbert G. Beck were appointed executors, qualified as such and have been acting in said capacity ever since.

3. That due notice was given to creditors of the time limited in which to file claims against said estate; that such time has fully expired, and all claims against said estate, including the expenses of her last illness and funeral and the costs and expenses of administration, have been paid in full; that the further presentation of claims against said estate have been forever barred by a former order entered herein; that there is no inheritance tax due the State of Nebraska and no federal estate tax due the United States of America.

4. That the report of the executors filed herein is in all things true, complete and correct and should be approved and allowed as their final report; that all the acts and doings of said executors should be approved; that there is no cash in the hands of the executors for distribution.

5. That the said Tena Beck died seized and possessed of the following described real estate, to-wit:

The Easterly 56 feet of the Northerly 75 feet of Lot 1, in Block 15, Original Town, now City of Grand Island, Hall County, Nebraska.
