On this 30th day of October, 1953, this cause coming on to be heard on the petition for a final settlement of said estate and on the final administration account, and the evidence was submitted to the court, on consideration thereof, the Court finds:

That on the 7th day of October, 1953, the said administratrix of the estate of the above named intestate filed in this Court her final administration account and a petition praying that the said account be settled and allowed, that the estate be distributed as required by law, that she be discharged from her trust as such administratrix, and that for these purposes citation be issued and notice be given to all persons entitled to notice, and settling the account, and that such citation be given thereof to the said heirs.

That on the 7th day of October, 1953, an order of this Court was made directing the 30th day of October, 1953 at 10 o'clock A. M. at the Court House of Hall County, Georgia

to the said administratrix to bring said petition and examine and settle said account, and requiring that notice of said citation be given to all persons entitled to be published a notice thereon in the Georgia State Gazette, a newspaper printed and published at the County Seat of Hall County, for three successive weeks prior to the date of said hearing.

That notice of said hearing has been duly given as required by the order of this Court.

That the said account is in full and correct.

That notice to creditors has been given.

That all claims allowed against said estate have been fully paid and satisfied; and

That said estate is full and solvent.

That the said deceased left surviving him as his heirs and legal heirs at law, the following named persons who are related to said deceased as herein stated.
