FINAL DECREE

Now on this 1<sup>st</sup> day of <sup>November</sup> ~~September~~, 1953, this matter came on to be heard upon the final account of the administratrix, the Application for Final Settlement thereof, and the evidence after being continued from the 18th day of September, 1953, and was submitted to the court,

THE COURT FINDS that George Mattison died intestate and a resident of Hall County, Nebraska on the 24th day of February, 1953. That a petition for probate for his estate was filed herein requesting appointment of Opal Mattison as administratrix thereof. That Opal Mattison qualified as administratrix thereof and she has faithfully performed her duties as such.

THE COURT FURTHER FINDS that due notice has been given to all creditors of said estate in the manner provided by law and in conformity with the prior order of this court. That there were no claims filed against said estate, and that an order has been entered barring all claims not filed.

THE COURT FURTHER FINDS that the account of the administratrix and the final report is in all things just, true and correct. That the items of receipt therein set forth are the total receipts of the administratrix of said estate and the list of items paid out are all proper charges against said estate.

THE COURT FURTHER FINDS that George Mattison left as his sole and only heirs at law and next of kin, the following: Rose Mattison, sister; Henry Mattison, brother, and none others. That all of said persons are of legal age at the time of his death.
