

## John M. Hanger.

ITEM ONE: I give, devise and bequeath to my wife, Tiena Hanssen, if she survive me, all my estate, real and personal, now owned by me or hereafter acquired, and wherever situated. I express the hope, without in any way making it compulsory, that she will not sell the home place comprising 160 acres South of Grand Island.

ITEM THREE: I nominate and appoint my said wife, Tiena Hansen, executrix of this will, if she survive, and should she die before me I nominate and appoint my said son, Arnold H. Hansen, to be executor of this will and I provide that neither my wife, or my son, if my wife should die before me, shall be required to give bond or surety as such executrix or executor.
