Henry Clausen, to have and to hold the same forever.

IT IS, THEREFORE, ORDIRED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED BY THE COURT that the Final Report of Hulda Essas Clausen, executrix, be end the same is and all things approved and allowed as and for the Final Report of the executrix and that said estate is hereby settled and elessed and that she is discharged as such executrix.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED BY THE COURT that all persons having claims against said estate, if any such there be, are foreber berrod, emjeined and excluded from setting up or asserting any such claims against said estate; that no part of the estate is subject to any inheritance tax under the laws of the State of Hebraska, nor to any Federal Estate tax under the laws of the United States, and that any real estate or other property owned by the decedent as a joint temant and which passed upon his death to the surviving joint temant, is last subject to any inheritance tax.

IT IS FURTHER OFDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED BY THE COURT that the distribution of the remaining personal property by the executrix to herself as calc deviace and beneficiary (except for three sets of Texas Longistus which have been delivered to George William Clausen, Robert Menry Clausen and the Ristorical Society of Hall County, Nebraska respectively) be and the same is hereby approved and that the real estate hereinabove described exmed by the decedent at the time of his death passed and descended a provided in the Last Will and Testement of the decedent.
