HUGH P. BAKER, DECEASED

FINAL DECREE

Now, on this 1<sup>st</sup> day of December, 1953, this cause came on for hearing upon the Final Report of Hugh L. Baker and Robert L. Baker, Administrators of the estate of Hugh P. Baker, deceased, and upon the Petition of said Administrators for the allowance and approval of said report, settlement of the estate, determination of inheritance tax, determination of heirs and order on distribution of assets and their discharge herein and the Court having examined the records and files herein and being fully advised in the premises finds that due and legal notice has been given to all persons of the time and place fixed by the Court for the hearing on said report and further finds that said report is true and correct in all things and that the same ought to be approved and allowed as and for the final report of said Administrators, said estate settled, and closed and the Administrators discharged.

The Court further finds that the said Hugh P. Baker, departed this life on May 22, 1953 and that at the time of his death he was a resident and inhabitant of Hall County, Nebraska; that his wife preceded him in death and that he left surviving him as his heirs at law and only heirs at law, two sons, they being Hugh L. Baker and Robert L. Baker, both of legal age; that the said Hugh P. Baker, deceased, died intestate and that on petition duly made his estate was admitted for administration and an order granting letters of administration to Hugh L. Baker and Robert L. Baker was issued July 1, 1953.

The Court further finds that due and legal notice has been given to all persons of the time and place fixed by the Court for filing claims against the estate of the deceased and that the time so fixed has fully expired and that all persons having claims against said estate and not filed within the time limited by the Court, are forever barred and excluded from setting up or asserting any such claims.
