FINAL DECREE

Now on this 2nd day of December, 1959, this cause came on to be heard upon the Final Report of Clara Marquardt, Administratrix, and now the Court, being fully advised in the premises and after having examined the records and files in this estate, finds that no objections have been filed to said Final Report, and finds that said Final Report is in all things true and correct; that the Administratrix has therein accounted for all of the goods and assets of the deceased which have come into her knowledge and possession and has in all matters complied with the orders of this court.

IT IS, THEREFORE, ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED by the court that said Final Report be and the same is hereby approved.

The Court further finds that notice has been given of the time fixed for filing claims in the manner and form provided by law; that the time fixed for filing claims has elapsed, and that all claims filed in the estate have been paid in full.

IT IS, THEREFORE, ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED by the Court that all claims not now on file be and the same are hereby forever barred.

The Court further finds that the expenses of the last illness and funeral expenses have been paid in full, and that the Administratrix has waived her fees as administratrix.
