Now on this 18th day of November, 1953, this matter came on to be heard upon the petition of Lorraine Olsen Lancaster of Van Nuys, California, praying that the Court may find and determine the time of death of the said Donald I. Olsen, deceased; that he died intestate; that all claims against said estate are paid or barred and who the heirs-at-law of the said Donald I. Olsen were at the time of his death, the degree of kinship and the right of descent of the decedent's interest in the Hall County real estate described in said petition.

THE COURT FURTHER FINDS that there has been no objection filed to said petition and no persons appeared to object to the same. Testimony was taken and having examined the files and records of this cause, the matter was submitted to the Court.

THE COURT FURTHER FINDS that a time had heretofore been fixed for hearing on said petition and there is on file with this Court proof that notice of the time and place of hearing was duly given to all persons interested in said estate as required by law and the Court now has jurisdiction to hear and determine said matter.

THE COURT FURTHER FINDS that all of the statements and allegations set forth in said petition are true; that Donald I. Olsen died intestate at Grand Island, Hall County, Nebraska, on the 24th day of December, 1946, seized and possessed at the time of his death of the following described real estate:
