IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED BY THE COURT that the household furniture and personal effects of the decedent together with all other property and articles that were exempt to the decedent at the time of his death pass and descend and are hereby assigned to his widow, Sophie Boersen, in absolute title.

The Court further finds that John Boersen died seized and possessed of the following described real estate:
