6. That by the terms and provisions of the last will and testament of the said Tena Beek, deceased, said real estate, together with any other property and bequeathed not now known or which may hereafter be discovered, was devised to her sons, the said Wilbur R. Beck and Delbert O. Beck, equally share and share alike.

IT IS, THEREFORE, CONSIDERED, ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED BY THE COURTS.

1.

That the report of Wilbur R. Beek and Delbert O. Beek, executors, filed herein be and the same is hereby in all things approved and allowed as and for their final account and in full settlement of their trust; that each and every act and doing of said executors be and the same are hereby approved; that they be discharged, and they and their swreties released from all further liability on their official bond.

II.

That the said Tenn Book died testate on April 20, 1953, a resident of Grand Island, Hall County, Nebrashs; that she left surviving her as her next of kin and heirs at law, Wilbur R. Book and Delbert G. Book, sons, both of legal age; that she left no husband, other living, children, or the living issue of any deceased children, and that said sons are the sole and only heirs of her estate.

That the real estate hereinbefere described, together with any other and bequeathed property not now known or which may hereafter by discovered, was devised/to the said Wilbur R. Book and Delbert G. Book by the terms and provisions of the last will and testament of the said Tena Book, deceased, and wis hereby assigned to them, equally share and share alike.
